

#### Equipment Guidelines:

- 1. Uniforms:
  - o Please bring a "good" karate do-gi for the seminars.
  - o It is recommended to bring an "old" do-gi for beach training on Monday.

#### 2. Traditional Kobudo Weaponry:

- o If you have the ability to travel with traditional kobudo weaponry, kindly bring a shindo stick (other weapons are optional).
- o For those unable to travel with sticks, Wado Canada will have a supply available for use during the relevant sessions.

#### 3. Kumite/Sparring Gear:

o If you own kumite/sparring gear, including mitts and foot pads, please bring them for any sessions that may involve sparring.

Accommodation: Limited billeting is available with local students in Victoria. If you indicate that you require billeting on your <u>Registration Form</u>, we will send you additional details on the billeting options.

We recommend the following hotel(s):

- Royal Roads University Dormitories/On-Campus Housing
  - o 2005 Sooke Road, Victoria, BC Canada V9B 5Y2 | <u>royalroads.ca</u> (3 minutes by car to seminar venue, 19 minutes to downtown Victoria)
  - Details: Ensuite rooms with private bathroom and queen bed, are \$140 per night plus tax (\$158.20), these can be single or double occupancy; Dorm rooms are single occupancy with a shared bathroom and common lounge/kitchen, at \$60 per night plus tax (\$67.80). At this time we are not accepting reservations for anyone under the age of 18.

  - Details: Room with 2 queen beds, @ \$269 + tax / night. Min. 2 night stay. Mention Group ID 6443988 at booking. 20 rooms are 'blocked' until July 3. Must reserve before July 3rd.

#### Transportation:

- Getting to Victoria:
  - o If arriving from Vancouver, consider taking the ferry or a flight to Victoria International Airport (YYJ).

- Getting around Victoria:
  - Wado Canada will provide a van to assist with transportation during the event (*Details to be communicated*)
  - o Public transportation and taxi services are readily available.

**Local Attractions:** While in Victoria, take the opportunity to explore the following local attractions (see <u>Tourism Victoria</u> for more information):

- 1. **Hatley Castle and Gardens:** Discover the historical charm and beautiful gardens of Hatley Castle, located near the event venue in Colwood.
- 2. **Royal BC Museum:** Immerse yourself in the natural and human history of British Columbia at the Royal BC Museum, situated in downtown Victoria.
- 3. **Butchart Gardens:** Experience the breathtaking floral displays and meticulous gardens at Butchart Gardens, just a short drive from Colwood.
- 4. **Fort Rodd Hill National Historic Site:** Explore the military history of the area at Fort Rodd Hill, featuring coastal artillery forts and bunkers with scenic coastal views.
- 5. **Downtown Victoria:** Enjoy the vibrant streets, local shops, and picturesque Inner Harbour in downtown Victoria, easily accessible from the event venue.
